

**APPLICATION FOR PERMIT AND VIOLATION FEES FOR THE KEEPING OF CHICKENS  
& DUCKS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF SILETZ**

One Year Permit – January to December of each year – renewable each January -  
\$ 10.00 - No pro-rating of fee.

Half Acre or less – up to a combination of six chickens or ducks

One Acre or more – up to a combination of ten chickens or ducks

**No Roosters or Drakes allowed**

- a. The keeping of chickens and ducks shall be permitted on properties used for single- family and two-family residential properties. Chickens and ducks shall be contained on the same premises where the owner of the birds resides.
- b. A Permit shall be obtained from the City prior to keeping of chickens and/or ducks on properties within the city. Permit fee to be established annually by the Siletz City Council and runs from January to December and is renewed annually.
- c. Properties that one-half acre or less are allowed no more that a combination of six (6) chickens and ducks. Properties exceeding one-half acre are allowed no more than a combination of the ten (10) chickens and ducks.
- d. The keeping of roosters shall be prohibited.
- e. Chickens and ducks shall be contained within the premises throughout the day. Chickens and ducks shall be contained throughout the night within an

enclosed coop or other structures to prevent dogs, coyotes, cats, raccoons and other predators and pests from accessing the birds. Enclosures containing the chickens and ducks that are separated from the main building may be located within five (5) feet of a rear property line and five (5) feet of the side property lines if the structure is no more than fifteen (15) feet in height. Structures over fifteen (15) feet must meet the standard setbacks.

- f. Food for chickens and ducks shall be stored in a secure area and in a metal or vermin proof container. When food is secured for the night, all food containers shall be secured.
- g. Chicken and/or duck enclosures shall be kept in good working and sanitary condition, and shall not cause odor or noise nuisances.

**VIOLATIONS OF SECTION 17.20**

Violation of Section 17.20 of the Siletz Municipal Code is a Class A Infraction with a maximum possible forfeiture of \$ 1,000.00 (Ord. No. 177. 16, 5-10-2007 and revocation of Permit to keep chicken or ducks.
