Special City Council Meeting Minutes

Monday, June 28, 2021 at 7:00pm

The Siletz City Council met and convened on Monday, June 28, 2021 and Mayor Worman called the Special City Council meeting to order at 7:20pm in the Siletz City Hall. Via www.gotomeeting.com (Covid-19) 7:00pm

ROLL CALL

Present were Mayor, Worman, Councilors, Susan Trachsel, Leslie Button and Jennifer Whitehead. Councilor G. Freer attended after a call for the Fire Department.

Also present was Sheila Jordan, Deputy Recorder, Tracey Viar, City Recorder and Robert Moody, Merina & Co. via GoTo meeting.

STATE SHARED REVENUES

Mayor Worman opened the public hearing on State Shared Revenues. City Recorder, T. Viar reported on the shared revenues and asked for public input on “Receiving State Shared Revenues and to Accept State Shared Revenue.” No public input was received, the public hearing was closed.

MOTION TO APPROVE RESOLUTIONS #'s 693 & 695

- a. Resolution #693 declaring the City of Siletz’s Election to Receive State Revenues – Councilor L. Button made a motion to approve Resolution #693, seconded by Councilor J. Whitehead. Motion approved.
- b. Resolution #695 certifying the Provision of Municipal Services by the City of Siletz for the Purposes of Participation in the State Revenue Sharing Program. Councilor L. Button made a motion to approve Resolution #695, seconded by Councilor S. Trachsel. Motion approved.

BUDGET 2021-22 FISCAL YEAR

Mayor Worman requested public input on the FY 2021-22 budget and Resolution #694. There were no Committee deliberation comments, Mayor Worman closed public input.

MOTION TO APPROVE FISCAL YEAR 2021-22 BUDGET

- a. Resolution #694 Adopting the City of Siletz, Oregon Budget for the 2021-22 Fiscal Year, Councilor S. Trachsel made a motion to approve Resolution #694, seconded by Councilor J. Whitehead. Motion approved.

DISCUSS RE-HIRE OF EMPLOYEE FOR PUBLIC WORKS

After extensive discussion between D. Viar, Public Works, Mayor Worman and the City Councilors, it was decided to re-hire Kenneth Tanner to Public Works. D. Viar will reach out to K. Tanner about Councils decision and a start date.

DISCUSS CITY HALL RE-OPENING

City Hall will open back up to the public on July 6, 2021 and masks will be required inside the building.

COVID-19 – UPDATE

Councilor Trachsel stated in Lincoln County there were 25 new cases of COVID and 4 hospitalizations for the month of June 2021. The Community of Siletz has a low vaccination rate percentage. The Lincoln County Health Department and the City of Siletz, will work together to schedule and offer a vaccination clinic at City Hall. The new Delta variant is a real concern for the medical field and our County.


ADJOURNMENT
